Jason went over the Meter repair list, approximately 6 meters. Blue Green Algae samples are being taken to Burlington daily.

Jason will be turning off water at the Vantine Avenue house that has been condemned. Jason was informed by Vtrans that Route 2 from Rouses Point Bridge to the four corners will be repaved, after discussion the Village will be repairing Valves and Bolts before paving begins fall of 2022. Jason took a class on GPS very impressed and thinks this would be something in the future for the Village to invest in. Hydrant flushing is planned for Week of October 18 thru the 29, Jason will order signage that displays Hydrant flushing to keep everyone safe and informed.
